

Schools and nurseries



Cherubs Day Nursery (0.3 miles)

A small rural nursery for babies, toddlers and pre-schoolers that's just a short walk from Lace Fields and rated "Good" by Ofsted.

Ruddington Day Nursery (1.3 miles)

A well-equipped nursery with two acres of outdoor play space for babies, toddlers and pre-schoolers, rated "Outstanding" by Ofsted.

James Peacock Infant and Nursery School (0.8 miles)

A mixed school with an "Outstanding" Ofsted rating for children aged from 3 to 7 years old.

St Peter's CofE Junior School (0.3 miles) A mixed school with a "Good" Ofsted rating for children aged from 7 to 11 years old.

Rosecliffe Spencer Academy (2.2 miles)

A new primary school that opened in September 2020 and caters for boys and girls aged from 3 to 11 years old.

Nethergate Academy (1.25 miles)

A school that caters for children and young people aged from 5 to 19 years old who have special educational needs. Rated "Outstanding" by Ofsted.

Farnborough Academy (1.4 miles)

A relatively new school that's now part of The Spencer Academies Trust and caters for boys and girls aged from 11 to 16 years old.

The West Bridgford School (2.4 miles)

A high performing secondary school for boys and girls aged from 11 to 18 years old and rated "Outstanding" by Ofsted.

Rushcliffe School (1.6 miles)

An excellent school for boys and girls aged from 11 to 18 years old that's rated "Outstanding" by Ofsted and is now also part of The Spencer Academies Trust.

Blessed Robert Widmerpool Catholic Primary School (2.1 miles)

An excellent primary school in Clifton for boys and girls aged from 3 to 11 years old. It's part of the Corpus Christi parish and The Spencer Academies Trust, and as such, is underpinned by strong Christian values and teachings. Rated 'Outstanding' by Ofsted.

Medical

It's important to know that there are services nearby that can take care of you and your family's health and Lace Fields gives you that peace of mind. In Ruddington you have easy access to The Ruddington Medical Centre and Ruddington Dental Practice, which is currently taking on private patients. Or you can hop in the car for a 5-minute drive to the Southchurch Family Dental Centre, which is a highly rated dental practice for NHS patients. For anything more urgent, Nottingham's biggest hospital The Queen's Medical Centre, is just 10 minutes away. And even the furry members of the family will be well looked after at Ruddington Vets or the local dog groomers.

Fitness & Wellbeing

Keeping fit and looking after your wellbeing is easy at Lace Fields. Roko Health Club, with its large gym, fitness classes, indoor and outdoor swimming pool, steam room, sauna and jacuzzi is less than 10 minutes by car and caters for everything, whether you want to unwind or work up a sweat. A similar distance in the other direction is Clifton Leisure Centre, which also provides a swimming pool, gym and fitness classes. Or for a bit of pampering closer to home, in Ruddington village you'll also find beauty salons, hair salons and a barber.

Outdoor

Your new home at Lace Fields is perfectly positioned to get out and about when you feel the need for some fresh air and scenery. Elms Park is just around the corner and has a small playground for the little ones. Or you can take a short walk to Rushcliffe Country Park, which provides 210 acres of picturesque parkland and includes a lake, playground, skate park and a BMX track. They also run events throughout the year to keep the whole family entertained. If you like a round of golf, Ruddington Grange Golf Club is just a 5-minute car ride away. Or if horse riding is more your thing, then The Lodge Equestrian Farm has a good riding school.

Shopping

All your shopping needs are catered for at Lace Fields. A handful of independent shops, charity shops and gift shops, as well as a butchers, bakers and a Co-op can be found in and around the village.

For the big weekly shop, you can hop in the car for no more than 10 minutes to Lidl, Asda or Aldi. Or for some serious retail therapy there is Nottingham city centre with its huge array of high street brands, department stores and independents.

Transport

Whether you're commuting for work in the week or exploring further afield at the weekend, Lace Fields is well connected to the local area as well as the rest of the Midlands. Head north on the A46 for Newark-On-Trent and Lincoln or go south to Leicester. You're also about 20 minutes from the M1, a gateway to the rest of the Midlands. Ruddington is catered for by a reliable bus service and Nottingham Train Station can easily connect you to Sheffield, Birmingham and London St Pancras.

Food and drink

When it comes to dining out or enjoying a few drinks, between Ruddington and Nottingham every taste and budget is catered for. In the village, you'll find a good selection of local pubs including the Ruddington Arms, The Frame Breakers and the White Horse Inn, as well as a selection of cafes and tea rooms for that all-important coffee and cake on the weekends. Ruddington Fish Bar, Three Spices and Happy Garden are the main local takeaways. And Nottingham has a vast array of pubs, bars and restaurants to choose from. Or for those special occasions, you can hop in the car or taxi to Sat Bains, a two Michelin Starred restaurant, or Alchemilla, a one Michelin Starred restaurant.

Being one of NHBC's Registered Builders doesn't just mean that we follow their house building standards; an NHBC expert inspects every one of our homes during key stages of the build, ensuring your home is finished to the very highest quality.

Then, when you move into a William Davis home it is immediately protected by NHBC Buildmark, a 10-year warranty and insurance policy that begins as soon as you exchange contracts. For the first two years your home is covered by our initial warranty, which means that if you have any problems with your home we'll sort things out. After the builder warranty has ended, your home will continue to be protected by our insurance cover until 10 years after completion.
